Two Memorable Shots in 50 Years of Bowhunting

I've kept a bowhunting diary since I started using the bow in August, 1959. In the diary, I've recorded ever animal that I've shot at and every animal that I've killed. For the numerous species I've killed, I've recorded the dates, location of the hunts, distance of the shots, sorted and labeled pictures, if any were taken, and jotted down other pertinent data. At the end of each year, I summarize the data and file it in a binder. I am now in the fourth volume. When I turn the pages of a volume, nearly 100% of the hunts flip clearly through my mind like flash cards. And the memories ... Ah!

I purposely won't mention how many animals that I've missed since 1959, to the present; it is a lot. I also know exactly how many I've killed from every class of vertebrates - little'uns to big'uns. My only regret is not taking more photos. At the time as a struggling A&M graduate student studying for a PhD in entomology and parasitology, it was more important to have hunting equipment than film and a camera. Besides, most of the animals that I shot went into the cooking kettle. A wife and three young sons needed meat.

I digress. Now, back to the history of those great - at least, I think so - shots. After all the non-game fishes, piles of frog legs, many bushy-tails, turkeys, feral hogs, and deer taken with bowhunting equipment, there are five kills that I remember clearly. The third and fourth were exceptionally vivid, and neither set any kind of record. I'll skip over the fifth - a bird - and begin with the third and end with the fourth.

The aluminum target arrow zipped toward the target before I realized it. Up to the time of this shot, I had made two perfect shots - both on cottontails. This textbook, third kill topped the rabbits.

Bob Barnes (graduate student) and I had finished a practice round at the Brazos Bowmen Field Archery Range on the A&M farm west of the main campus. It was May 20, 1963. Instead of taking the usual route to my campus apartment, I took a graveled backroad for no particular rea-son. It

certainly wasn't a short-cut to the apartment.

Clipping along with nothing special on my mind, I casually noticed a male Boat-tailed Grackle sitting on a cedar fence post on the right. (Black bird species weren't protected then.) I slowed to a stop, backed up, and stopped. I quietly stepped from the Renault 4-CV with my Wing Presentation and a target arrow. I ducked down and eased to the rear of the car. I nocked the arrow. Slowly, I stood up and judged the distance to be about twenty yards. (I shot field targets using the gap-sighting system.) The male was about 20 yards from where I stood. I drew, aimed, and released. The arrow was gone in less than a heart beat. The arrow passed through the bird. Momentarily, it remained on the post and then toppled to the ground. This was the third best of the five shots.

Here is the account of the fourth memorable shot of the five best. Many, many years later - twenty-six, to be exact - I made the shot on a white-tail spike.

The shadows were lengthening as I trudged along the cow trail leading to the honey hole treestand, located in a hollow live oak. Honey bees had occupied the hollow for years, until the horrific freeze of 1983-84 wiped out the hive. A bowhunter had built a stand in the oak after the killing freeze and named the stand, the honey hole.

The evening shadows disappeared as the evening transitioned into night. The trail was visible without using a flashlight. Besides, I don't like to use a flashlight unless I really have to; the light spooks the animals, especially deer.

About ten minutes of legal shooting time remained.

As I walked around a persimmon tree, I noticed a deer feeding calmly beneath the feeder. I paused a few seconds to watch the deer and decided to take a shot if the flight path were clear. It was ... no overhanging limbs to deflect the arrow. I drew the 55-lb. pull Bear bow and placed the 40-

yard sight pen on the deer's right shoulder.

"What the heck; it's still legal shooting time," I thought and squeezed the Hot Shot release. I lost sight of the 2018, aluminum Game Getter arrow, tipped with a 3-bladed Satellite broadhead, half way to the deer, but I heard the loud Whack! of the arrow when it slammed into the deer. I stepped off the distance; it was 39 yards - longest shot I've ever made on a deer.

I sat down and waited 20 minutes before walking to my truck. I drove slowly to the camp house. I told Alice about the deer, and we decided to get it before the coyotes did. We tracked the deer far into the night before we quit and returned to the camp house. Early the next morning, we started at the blood trail marker and lost the trail on a rocky slope.

Three days later, while milling around along the slope, I smelled a dead animal. I found the spike beneath a large clump of cedar trees (junipers). The deer had traveled nearly a mile from where I had shot it.

Although this was the fourth best shot of the five I had made, I haven't made another better than this one the evening of October 28, 1989, that deserves to be called my sixth best shot.
