





Article VII Leadership Structure





# Bowfishing Records Are Made to Be Broken by Bob Morrison

Bowfishing records are made to be broken. This is similar to the old cowboy saying, "Not a horse that can't be rode; not a cowboy that can't be throwed."

Some bowfishing records - for the smallest species to the largest - withstand the age of time for decades before new records displace them. This includes private waters, Water Body Records, and State Records.

I've had the pleasure of holding a couple of Water Body Records for several years. One for more than fifteen years, and one for twenty-five. This doesn't bother me that they're broken; it just stimulates me to do more bowfishing. I'd rather bowfish than bowhunt for whitetail deer.

Here is a brief histoy of the two records that replaced mine. Both are for the Smallmouth Buffalofish, <u>lctiobus bubalas</u>, a wide-ranging species in the U.S. It is found in most of Texas reservoirs, lakes, rivers, and streams, but with a very limited distribution - if any - in the Pan Handle.

In the Cross Timbers of Texas, there are many large lakes, and I live withing an hour's drive or less from four excellent ones. Namely, near my home of Stephenville, there are four lakes: Palo Pinto, Proctor, Possum Kingdom, and Leon. They have large populations of buffalofish, European carp, longnose and spotted gar, gaspergou, and gizzard shad. To hunt just be legal when you launch your boat or step into the water to wade. And, dispose of the fish properly if you don't use them someway. There are many uses for these fishes.

Of the lakes I casually mentioned, I'll start with a Smallmouth Buffalo Fish that I shot on July 9, 1975. The fish was rather small, but it withstood the age of time, until April 29, 2000, when a 11.15 pounder blasted my Water Body Record to pieces.

I was bowfishing with Logan Carpenter, a graduate student of Biology at Tarleton State University. It was a hot July day, and I parked my pick-up truck in the parking area at the SH 16 bridge over the Brazos River, below the Possum Kingdom dam.

As I strung my bowfishing rig, I said, "Logan, since you're not hunting, how about you take care of the camera work?" He agreed with a nod of his head and took the camera from the pick-up seat.

"Where you want to start?" he asked.

"I guess the shallow water on the north side of the bridge and make our way up to the spillway. It's not too far and good bowfishing for carp

and spotted gar," I answered. "If the Corps of Engineers start to open a dam gate or two, we'll have plenty of time to get ashore," I added.

"Sounds good to me," he called over his shoulder as he stepped into the water. I followed as I put on my polaroid glasses and nocked a fishing arrow, tipped with a Shur Point.

Within sight of the highway bridge, I spotted a group of four buffalofish fanning in the shallows. I hissed at Logan and pointed. He nodded in reply. I crouched down and waded slowly toward the lazy unconcerned fish. Talking quietly to myself, I eased, step-by-step, toward the fish. "Another step, if they don't spook, I'll shoot." They didn't.

Slowly, I straightened up, drawing my 50-lb. pull Red Wing Hunter, aimed below the largest fish, and released. Plop! The fiberglass arrow zipped through the fish. Later, I weighed the fish on certified scales - a Water Body Record of 4.25-lbs. (Photo #1)

The second Water Body Record didn't survive but six years. The 8.06-lb. Smallmouth Buffalo was shot at Lake Proctor, just north of U.S. Hwy. 67/377, thirty miles from my drive-way.

I parked in the day park, a mile off the U.S. highway, readied my equipment, and stepped into the cool water. Carp were grubbing along the shoreline, gar were popping the surface, and buffalo were rubbing fins with the carp.

I pinned and strung five carp and a couple of buffalo on the stringer. None of the fish were anything to brag about. I continued to wade the shallow water and "put a hurt" on several more busy fish. The stringer was loaded. I waded ashore and walked to the pick-up to put the fish in the icechest.

"You know?" I thought, "One of the buffalo might be a Water Body Record." Since, there wasn't a record for the species listed for Proctor, I had the fish officially measured and weighed. It made the record book.

This record was broken in less than seven years. I'm sure there is a new record in Proctor waiting for me. I may not get it, but I'll be flingin' arrows, tipped with Shur Shot points.




