



Pevehouse Turkey

During a casual conversation with retired army Sargent Johnson of Stephenville, then a part-time state employ and a hunt master of a ranch near Tarpley, Texas, mentioned bowhunting. My ears perked up, and immediately asked about leasing. Not tong into the conversation, I made a deal with Sarge for a weekend bowhunt. He agreed to a late October weekend hunt. After settling up the cost for the hunt, Sarge gave me a map to the 3,000 acre Pevehouse Ranch, south of Tarpley. He said we could bunk in the vacant house used by the braceros (Mexican migrant workers). We agreed on an October weekend.

The Hill Country bowhunt began on Friday, October 26, 1973. Sarge said there shouldn't be any problem finding turkey or deer. I was anxious for a gobbler, for I'd never bagged a turkey using the bow.

Billy Rumbo, my partner for the newly formed Lone Star Bowhunter Magazine, picked my up at noon on the 27th. We made the 220 mile trip in his blue, 2-door Pinto and arrived at the ranch after dark. The grandson of the owner, half saturated with booze, was standing on the front porch when we drove to the ranch house. He gave us directions to the bunkhouse and where to turn on the electricity. He neglected to tell us there were several problems with the accommodations.

The house was barren ... no running water, no bunks, and a hard, wooden floor.

There was electricity but no light bulbs.

We walked in and waved our flashlights around.

"Sure lots of rat dirt on the floor," Billy said as he flashed his light from one side of the single, room house to the other. "At least, there're screens on the doors and windows," he continued inspecting the place."

"Well, Rumbo, pick out a soft plank or two and unroll your sleeping bag while I unpack," I answered.

"Thank goodness we brought pillows," he replied as he scraped out a clean spot among the rat dirt for his sleeping bag.

"What time should we set the alarm?" I asked after dumping my sleeping bag and hunting gear.

"Heck, Morrison, since we don't know where to hunt, why don't we get up around daylight, do a little scouting, and set up for Saturday evening and Sunday morning? As many deer and turkey as Sarge says there's suppose to be on the place, we shouldn't have trouble finding a place to ambush a deer or turkey. Besides, we can scatter corn; that'll help."

I replied, "Fine. Let's hit the sack. Maybe we can get some rest before the floor kills our backs."

What a miserable night! Between the two of us, we must have rolled over 2,000 times and complained ten times that. Each time one of us awakened cussing, it awakened the other. We'd utter serious expletives and doze until our aching bones complained again.

I thought the alarm would never go off. Finally, it rattled loudly. What a relief. And sore as if I'd been whipped with a dead rabbit.

Rumbo commented while we were eating, "Sarge is suppose to be here today. If he can't fix us up with mattresses or some type of padding, I'm going to Hondo and buy one."

"Good idea," I said gulping down the last swig of coffee.

Rumbo was having some sort of lower back or tail-end problems. I don't recall. Whatever it was, he hurt the entire trip. Sleeping on the floor only agitated the problem.

We drove the ranch roads and found a couple of hot spots; at least, the numerous tracks indicated so. Sarge was waiting for us when returned to camp.

"Sarge, what a miserable night. We thought there were bunks with mattresses. The floor certainly made for painful sleeping, what little we got."

"Well, I think I can fix you up if you don't mind sleeping on mattresses used by the braceros. The mattresses have been stored in the barn for a while; don't know what shape they're in. But they might get you through the weekend. I'll rustle you a couple of light bulbs from the ranch house, even if I have to steal them from the grandson."

After lunch, Rumbo and I drove to the hunting area and parked. While stringing our bows, turkeys called up the canyon to the south of us.

"Rumbo, let's split up; maybe we can get a shot at a gobbler. If you'll go up the canyon floor, I'll slip along the east ridge. We'll meet here in an hour."

We hadn't left the car more than fifteen minutes when a frog-strangling shower blew in. I hunkered near a ledge for protection. I got drenched.

The turkeys began yelping, cackling, and gossiping in general when the shower moved on to the south. They were below the ledge a couple hundred yards. I got a bearing on the flock and moved slowly down the ridge toward the floor of the canyon, hoping to be in front of the birds. I set up in a persimmon thicket beside a goat trail, which I thought they were on.

The noisy birds moved slowly along the trail but steadily in my direction. The first thing I saw through the brush was the snaky-looking heads bobbing to and fro as they ambled along the trail.

"Yeah, they're on the trail," I lipped the words.

The birds, in single file, strolled closer. I drew, took a deep breath, expelled a bit, and waited. The lead bird stepped clear of brush momentarily and instantly became suspicious. Immediately, it gave the alarm.

Too late. The arrow zipped through its body just beneath its left wing, as the turkey turned to run. It flushed straight up, flapped its wings a few times, and crashed within 30 yards of my ambush.

Thoroughly drenched but happy, I picked up the bird and trudged back to the Pinto. Rumbo was sleep in the front seat.

I knocked on the window and asked if he had been in the car all this time.

"Sure as heck have. I wasn't going to follow those birds in that downpour!"

"You candy butt. We came to hunt, not to sleep. Where's your camera?

"I didn't bring one. You got one?"

We both looked blankly at each other.

The mattresses smelled of barn yard odors and nights of human occupancy. But, Lordy, Lordy, did they feel good that night. Never noticed the odors; never even heard the rats playing tag on the cabin's rafters.

Splash-day For the Spring Carpfest In The Cross Tim-

After the last freeze in the Cross Timbers, usually the latter part of March, I regularly check three local lakes near Stephenville, TX, for carp gathering in the shallows for the annual spawn. Once a week until the spawn kicks in, I make a circle of the lakes, starting with Lake Palo Pinto, 30 miles north of Stephenville. From there, I swing down to 1H20, to Lake Leon, and stop at my favorite backwaters where the carp congregate to spawn.

Leaving the Leon, I turn onto FM 2214, to SH16, south to Lake Proctor. Checking the brushy areas at Foley's Point and the day parks near the dam, I'm finished with the scouting for another week. As winter fades and the Spring Equinox slowly appears, the lakes' waters begin to lose their winter chill, the carp notice the change, too. The urge to spawn begins. Things begin to pop... a primeval frenzy that bow fishermen have been awaiting.

In the meanwhile before the frency, bowfishermen check their gear, boats, sharpen fishing points, replace batteries in their headlights, etc. I do all this except get a boat ship-shape or hunt at night. I'm a daylight, wading carp bowfisherman. I detest fighting nocturnal insects and all of the other tributations that happen during a night hunt. Of course, hunting at night is exciting and successful, since larger carp are active. But, I prefer the daylight; I'm not looking for records or size - just out to enjoy the sport.

The spawn begins with a trickle, gains momentum, and then, explodes: carp everywhere in the shallows, oblivious to everything except procreating. It's the time bowfishermen have been awaiting.

I like to be on the shoreline by dawn. Armed and ready to fling arrows.

I have a rules that I abide by: (1) keeping the fish - no tossing'em onto the bank to rot nor throwing them into the water (2) field dressing them for future use and placing them in an ice-chest. Do not throw the offal into the lake or on the land. (Causes bad relationships with landowners, state, and lake officials. Instead, I give the carp to friends that utilize the fish as food, fish bait, pet food, and trapping bait. Busy-body work? Yes, but it's good public relationships.

The old bugle-mouth, European import was suppose to boost the U.S economy in the 18OOs, but soon the fish became a nuisance that spread across the U.S.

Whether you prefer night or day bowfishing, there are cardinal rules that should be followed:

(1) Tell someone where you're bowfishing and when you'll return (2) Give them your cell phone

number, if you have one (3) Carry a valid hunting and fishing license (4) If possible, contact the local Game Warden and give your name, when, where, and approximately how long you'll be bowfishing (5) Take care of the fish you kill and dispose of the offal properly (6) Enjoy the outing but be careful and safe.

When Springs and lake waters reach the magical temperature range of 72-to-76 degrees, gear up and join the annual ritual of the carp spawn.

I'd rather bowfish than hunt other game animals.









