




Billy Rumbo with a Texas Hill Country feral goat, shot in the early 1970's

### In Memory: Billy Gus Rumbo of Maud, Texas

### Pioneer in Texas Bowhunting

n the summer of 1973, because summer employment at Tarleton State University was so "Iffy", extra money was necessary to carry my young family through the summer until the Fall semester started at Tarleton, I, as an ardent bowhunter, researched the Texas bowhunting annuals and noticed there weren't state clubs or organizations solely devoted to bowhunting. With, at the time, more than 70,000 Texas bowhunters, I decided the State needed a bowhunting organizations and magazine. In July, 1973, I published the first issue of the Lone Star Bowhunter Maga-zine. It was on its way of becoming a success until the 1974 recession.

Between July, 1973 and then, Billy Rumb of Maud, Texas, met me in Glen Rose, Texas to discuss the organization and magazine. Billy, at the time, had a guiding service and a bowhunting directory. (Later, he published a turkey hunting booklet.) During the meeting, we formed a partnership. Things were promising. We had subscriptions from 20 states, and a couple of foreign countries, China to name one.


In June, 1974, at the Ramada Inn in Stephenville, Texas, Billy and I brought together a group of Texas bowhunters. Around midnight, before the meeting adjourned, Billy appointed an executive council and a president - James Orange of Bellville, Texas. The Lone Star Bowhunters Association (LSBA) was born. Billy and I gave the Magazine to the newly formed association. The LSBA flourished under several hardworking presidents and executive councils.

In April, 2016, Billy Gus Rumbo passed on to his reward after vigorously fighting strokes. After his seventh, he went into a coma and didn't come out of it.



What had Rumbo (my favorite name for him) accomplished during his tenure in the bowbending career? A lot the majority of bowhunters and archers didn't know or even dreamed Rumbo was so active in. First, before listing some of these, he was an expert gunner in the Army and served in Viet Nam. It was there that he learned the trade of repairing, re-building, and restoring rifles. But, always, he was acutely aware of and a mentor of bowhunting. Here are a few of his activities and accomplish-ments.

- (1) First to found a bowhunting organization within the State Texas Bowhunter.
- (2) Owner of the first Texas bowhunting publication The Texas Bowhunter, which he sold to me.
- (3) First to own and publish a bowhunting guide service in the State.
- (4) First to own and publish a turkey directory in the State.
- (5) An arbitrator for International Harvester Union while employed. He retired from the company and devoted his time to gunsmithing, buying, trading, and selling bows.
- (6) He was a part-time taxidermist.
- (7) He was devoted to the outdoors and promoted it constantly.

Rumbo slipped quietly away in his sleep. His ashes scattered over his beloved Hill County around Adamsville, Texas.

What great memories I have of us driving around that part of the Hill Country. Rumbo, enjoy the view from above and remember us.

Joined the U.S. Air Force 10 days after graduating from High School, June, 1966.



as a Assistant Fire Chief.











### Swing Fast & Way Ahead of Doves

### by Bob Morrison

Dawn on a scraggly oat field taken over by sunflowers...

I was waiting for the dove season to open.

I was sitting under a mesquite tree at the edge of a small patch of sunflowers. The rising sun was at my back. My ambush was within bow range to fling special bird arrows at the birds when they approached the sunflowers. I was confident the home-made arrows would be effective out to 20 yards. Beyond that, the flu-flus would loose

velocity and spiral to the ground.

The doves would soon to be off their roosts and ready for a breakfast of shattered oats and sunflower seeds.

I glanced at my watch - just a few minutes more before the Guns of Autum would blast in the season. But no one would hear me, as I thought about my equipment.

I had tried commercial bird points but was dissatisfied with them. I was sure I could make a better point, using a 100-grain field point tipped with a 7 1/2-in, steel wire. It was simple enough to make and should work. I mulled over my point. Here is my prototype:

First - with the point in a vice, drill a 1/16-in, hole through it just below the point's shoulder; ream out the hole to enlarge it slightly.

Second - taper the wooden shaft with a tenon tool to fit the field point; glue the field point onto the shaft.

Third - cut a piece of flexible steel wire, 7 1/2-in, long. Fill the hole in the point with epoxy glue.

Fourth - quickly run the wire through the point so there is an equal amount of wire jutting from each side of the point. Let dry thoroughly.

Fifth - finally, take some fine steel wire and tightly figure-8 wrap the wire around the point and secure. Thickly coat the wire with epoxy. Let dry 24 hours.


\*The completed arrow with 5-in, flu-flu fletching has an effective range of 20 yards, using a 50-lb. bow. Arrow speed and range can be increased using the same bow and arrows fletched with plastic hunting vanes.

The early birds braked their speed and dropped toward the sunflowers nearest to the mesquite. I drew, quickly caught up with a bird, pulled ahead of what I thought would be enough for a kill, and released. Pooch! Not even close enough to alter the feathered speedster's landing. The arrow passed a good ten feet behind the bird. Next shot I increased the lead and speed. Same results but close enough to scare the dove.

I shot; missed; ran out of arrows; and had to retrieve the arrows. And sit disgruntled under the mesquite. With each subsequent shot, the arrows passed closer to the bird. Finally, after six trips to retrieve arrows, I got wild and swung fast and way past a bird before releasing. Yep! I killed it. How many shots did it take to bag this bird? Let me count. It was twice the number of my fingers, toes, and two ears.

I went home tired but satisfied. I recorded the morning hunt in my bowhunting diary. It was a good hunt. Over the years, I realize a bowhunt can be fun and enjoyable without killing. Also, I might add that I haven't bowhunted doves again.






