



My name is KC Kreger, I have been doing leatherwork for the past 28 years. My leather work career began in Oklahoma City in 1989. There I was hired and trained for 9 months with a Fort Worth based, nationwide, leathercraft supplier. 

Odell Wandering

Somewhere in my wandering around and through a used book store in Central Texas, I perused a small booklet written by the Amish. The contents varied from home medical remedies, homecooking, to kitchen tips.

Many of these tidbits were worth remembering, but two stood out ... both kitchen jewels. The first (Kitchen Cutting Board Deep Sanitiza-tion), uses a half cup of white vinegar, three tablespoons of salt, and two tablespoons of vegetable oil. This is for wooden cutting boards:

- 1. Sprinkle salt over board and let set five minutes.
- 2. Scrub salt with a vinegar wash.
- 3. Rinse with hot water.
- 4. Dry with a dry cloth.
- 5. Occasionally, rub down board with vegetable oil.

The second tip goes along with the above tip. It is for cleansing countertops. Fill a spray bottle with a mixture of equal parts of white vinegar and water. Spray the tops of the counter with the mixture and wipe off the solution with a clean dry cloth. Or, let air dry.

The two tips are great when cutting and wrapping game. Remember: Dull knives are more dangerous than sharp ones.

Accidents afield are more common that most anglers and hunters realize. Here is a ditty that should be used for shock:

"Face red; elevate head."

"Face pale; elevate tail."

There are many causes for shock: Falls, sprains, cuts, broken bones, etc. Take care and always be award when afield.

With bow season not too far off. You might want to start mending equipment, checking portable treestands, repairing feeders, coon/squirrel proofing deer feeders.

While waiting for a photo, the clerk and I started talking about deer hunting. I mentioned having trouble with the varmints shinning up the legs of the feeders and emptying the

feeders, even though we had tried all sorts of ways and gimmicks to stop the thieving critters, even attaching prickly pear cactus on the legs. Nothing seemed to work.

He said I should do what he does for his feeders to prevent this: simply heavily grease the legs with Crisco shortening. I looked at him skeptically. He read the belief on my face and said, "Sounds goofy, but it works. Try it next season."

Why not? Might work, and it might attract deer.



Odell Wanderings

Approaching more than four score (80) and ten years, a person slows down, thinking of "yester years", with the help of a diary recording memories faithfully of each hunt ... whether successful or just another pleasant day afield.

Thus, Odell Wanderings popped into mind while high in a treestand, while waiting for dawn when an unsuspecting deer might wander into bow range. Oh my! How one's mind can wander and wonder.

During those mornings back in 1959, bowhunting on the Carson Pryor ranch, just north of Wheelock, Texas, I started my diary of every hunt. The first entree in the diary was a cotton rat shot at the Brazos Bowmen Field Archery Range on the Texas A&M college farm. Over the years many entrees have been recorded. Why the busy-body work? They say: "Your greatest memory is only as good as your faintest ink." True. I can thumb through the pages of the diaries (now in the 4th. volume) and recall nearly every hunt. And, relive each one.

So ... I want to share those memories with others that hunt with a "crooked stick and pointed sticks." These memories to share will be tips and "how to".

For the first Odell Wandering is an elixer found in every kitchen - and should be in every hunter's backpack: A small bottle of brown vinegar. This slightly acidic liquid has many uses. Here are some examples:

But, first a short story of brown vinegar, involving a dear friend retired from the Southern Pacific Railroad. Marvin Dean gulped down a teaspoon of brown vinegar every morning before his first cup of strong black coffee. He claimed the vinegar "kept the body fluids in balance." He claimed he has done this morning ritual since he was ten years old. Must have worked since he died in his late 80s ... "four score and ten".

In checking the literature, here is a list of uses:

- 1. Season food, especially fish.
- 2. Remove fishy odors hands, cutting board, skillet.
- 3. Removing grease from cooking utensils.
- 4. Salad dressing, especially plain or mixed with oil.
- 5. Soothing arthropod bites and stings.
- 6. Soothing bull nettle and other plant irritants.
- 7. A mild antiseptic.
- 8. A dilute solution for gargling for a sore throat.
- 9. Easing the pain of a painful sunburn by rubbing undiluted vinegar over burned areas. Do not get into the eyes.
- 10. Use as a household grease remover.
